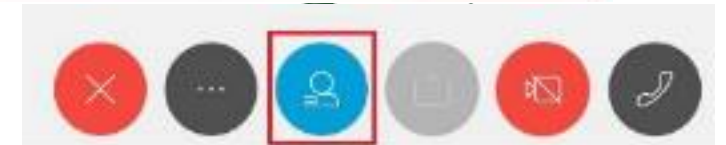
Meeting Procedures

Written Feedback Methods
